(RSWs) are professional rehabilitation facilitators that work one-on-one with clients to meet rehabilitation plan objectives. They provide a client-centred service in emotional support, cognitive and functional programming.

Social Work Associates

Provide psychosocial support, psychoeducation & community liaison to individuals, couples and families. We offer assessment & treatment that is client-centred & strength based, using evidence-based best practice treatment modalities.

Personal Support Workers
